Feeding by adult shortnose sturgeon in freshwater portions of Saint John River, Canada (Dadswell 1979), is confined largely to periods when water temperature exceeds 10 C. A temperature decl ine of 2 to 3 C during fall stimulated downriver migration to overwintering sites in the Pee Dee River, South Carolina (Dadswell et al. 1984), and a decrease in temperature from 19 to 11 C stimulated fall migration in the Connecticut River (Buckley and Kynard 1985a).
