

In the decade that followed, starkly different in character, much of the madness & extravagance was replaced with social satire & political comment, but the momentary escape revues continued to provide was perhaps treasured even more than before. With the coming of Word War II, when escapism blended with patriotism & restraint, the traditional revue form had entered its final phase. Soon its glory, glamour & glitz were dimmed by the ubiquitous light of the...
